





Brief Formulary: Barriers Creams for community use



When skin damage is due to moisture or pressure remove the cause.

Assess and document skin assessment regularly in accordance with your organisation's policy. Step up and down treatment based on skin condition.

Seek specialist tissue viability advice if skin is not healing.

Cleanse with	Product (photo of product)	Application & useful advice
① Skin protection from incontinence or promoting healing if skin damage is minimal		
Soap (ph 5.5) and water	Zerolon barrier cream* 28g & 92g 	Apply twice daily – morning and evening.
② Skin protection from wound exudate		
Cleanse gently with plain water. If not tolerated consider Senset Skin Cleansing Foam	Cavilon* Barrier film with applicator wand 1ml size 	Apply when completing wound dressing <u>Lasts up to 72 hours</u> Re-apply at every dressing change
③ Treatment of damaged skin		
Senset Skin Cleansing Foam 	Medihoney* 	Medihoney is an active treatment of damaged skin Should heal in a month
