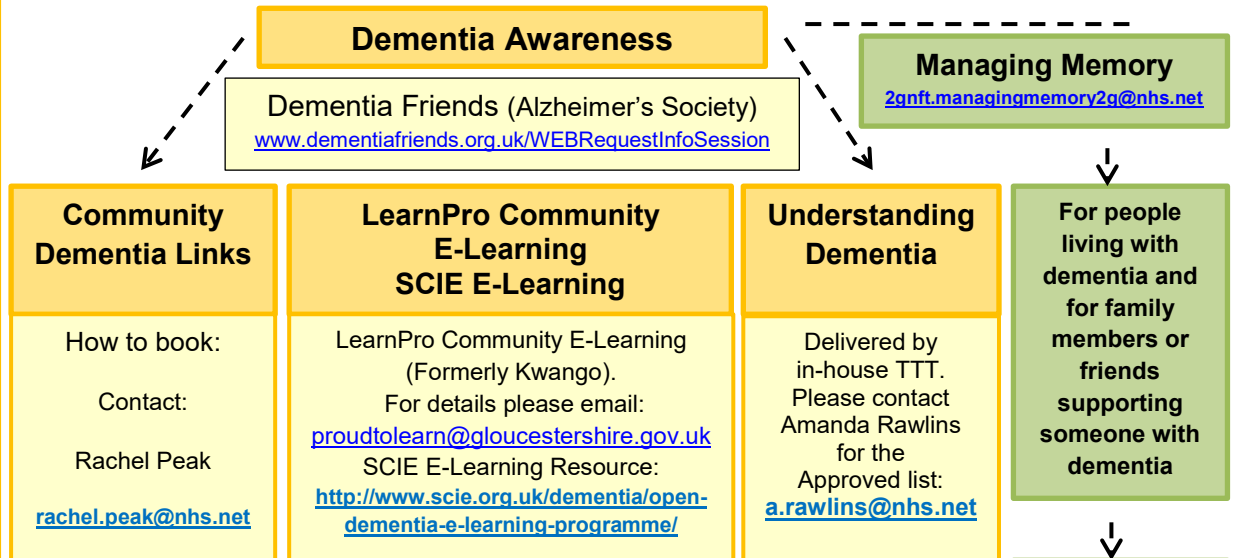

How do I register?

- To obtain LearnPro user guide/ registration details contact: proudtolearn@gloucestershire.gov.uk
- Register with LearnPro Community.
- Please complete all fields and then click 'next' to continue.
- Under Location please select the service area that best describes the sort of service your organisation provides. If none of them apply please select other.
- Type in your organisation's name and click finish.
- When you first login after registering you will need to accept the Terms and Conditions

How do I book following registration?

Course Length – 20 mins x 7 Modules

Community Dementia Link (CDL) – Course

Length 12 hours. Bespoke education packages delivered to those public members outside of statutory roles to encourage individuals and groups to carry out projects that involve and support the person with dementia and their carers. The course aims to meet the needs of the local community as well as the group and is usually held over 4 separate sessions totalling 12 hours' training.

One Day Dementia Training - Course Length 1 Day

This one day training programme supports the learner to gain a good understanding of dementia and the changing brain, including person centred principles and communication approaches. It aims to build on the skills and techniques that the learner has, and will be using, when supporting people with dementia and their families.

Dementia Link Worker Award

Course Length – 10 weeks

The Dementia Link Worker Award comprises 10 half day workshops (8 core workshops & at least 2 additional chosen workshops) to be undertaken within 20 weeks.

You will also be asked to complete a written Reflective account based on your own practice to complete the programme successfully.

This course is fully funded by the Gloucestershire Dementia Training Strategy.

Please note that the City & Guilds accredited award will no longer form part of the DLW programme.

Dementia Lead Award

Course Length- 10 weeks

The course is open to anyone in a position of leadership within their organisation such as clinical leads, managers, commissioners etc.

The course comprises 10 half day workshops (8 core workshops & at least 2 additional chosen workshops) to be undertaken within 20 weeks.

We will be asking you to put forward an action plan which outlines an idea to make a change that will improve the lives of people with dementia and their carers who access your service in collaboration with others that you work with.

This course is fully funded by the Gloucestershire Dementia Training Strategy.

Train the Trainer Workshop.

Course Length - 1 Day with follow up Mentoring in Practice

Designed for people who provide training within their organisation and who would like to develop their confidence in delivering dementia awareness training.

Participants are provided with training resources and the workshop is followed by an observation of the participant's delivery of *Understanding Dementia* in their workplace.
