There is also information available about whether you need a licence from your local authority for public entertainment on the Citizen's advice website <u>www.citizensadvice.org.uk</u> Or contact your local authority directly to discuss your requirements as performing in a care setting may not be regarded as a public place.

General consensus among the Activity Co-ordinator Network is if an entertainer or group is coming to your care setting as a business, then they must have public liability insurance.
