Freedom of Information Request – Ref: FOI 003-1819

Thank you for your recent Freedom of Information request about harassment and stalking of staff by patients. Please find the Trust's response below.

- 1) Does your Trust have a policy regarding harassment by patients? If so, please could you provide a copy or link to it?
 - There is no actual policy for this but the Local Security Management Specialist (LSMS) has produced a guidance document on harassment and Stalking (attached); this has been shared with a number of agencies for their consideration including the Police and the Hollie Gazzard Trust.
 - The Trust also uses NHS Protect guidance for any online problem with relation to the use of social media (attached)
- 2) Does your Trust have a policy regarding stalking by patients? If so, please could you provide a copy or link to it?
 - See above.
- 3) What is the process for dealing with harassment or stalking of staff by patients when a staff member reports it?
 - These are reported and recorded via the DATIX system.
 - If the harassment or stalking of staff by patients is taking place within the confines a hospital it is initially dealt with by the LSMS, however if the problem emanates from any former patient then this is always referred to the Police as they have primacy.
- 4) Are staff given training on harassment and/or intrusions on privacy by patients? If so, what form does this take?
 - The Trust has used external speakers who have attended the Trust to speak to staff members and managers about Harassment, Stalking and Coercive control such as Dr Jane Monckton Smith. Staff have also attended training conferences presented jointly by Gloucestershire Police and the Hollie Gazzard Trust.
