## Freedom of Information Request – Ref: FOI 029-1819

Thank you for your recent Freedom of Information request about medical staffing. Please find the Trust's response below.

- In the last 12 months, how many visa applications did the hospital process and were accepted for their permanent doctor placements? 2 Clinical Fellow Posts
- In the last 12 months have you used an agency to fill your permanent doctor positions? Yes
- In the last 12 months, which agencies have you used for your permanent doctor positions you have filled? The Trust uses agencies on the HTE Framework
- In the last 12 months, how many doctors have been placed in permanent roles via an agency?
  Unfortunately, the Trust is unable to respond to this question. The Trust estimates that the work involved in collating the data in order to respond would exceed the 18 hours limit, specified in Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act and therefore, exceeds the appropriate limit of £450.
- In the last 12 months, how much have you spent on agencies for your permanent doctor placements? £1,974,301
- How much are you charged per permanent doctor placement as per grade below?
  - 1. SHO's (this includes FY1, FY2, ST1, ST2, CT1, CT2, StR Lower, Clinical fellow, Trust grade, RMO) The minimum cost per hour was £54.01 and the maximum cost per hour was £54.01 in 2017/18
  - SPR's (this includes ST3, ST4, ST5, ST6, ST7, CT3, CT4, StR Higher, Senior Clinical Fellow, Registrar, Staff Grade, Middle Grade, Speciality Doctor)
     The minimum cost per hour was £46.41 and the maximum cost per hour was £73.00 in 2017/18
  - Consultants (this includes Associate specialist, Lead Consultants, Consultant Physician)
    The minimum cost per hour was £76.00 and the maximum cost per hour was £125.65 in 2017/18

- Who was successful with the tender allocation? N/A
