Please make clear what the waiting time target is and how many children and teenagers are seen within that target time.

Please note that all waiting times are unadjusted, the weeks from referral to treatment start date does not recalculate for cancellations or non-attendance.

During 2016/7 and 2017/18 the Children and Young Peoples Service within 2gether Foundation NHS Trust was able to maintain referral to treatment waiting times within the national target time of 18 weeks. However since 2018 an increase in demand, alongside staffing capacity challenges has led to an increase in waiting times from referral to treatment and the percentage of children and young people being seen within 18 weeks has reduced from 91% in 2017/18 to 72% in 2018/19.
