  - c. Mechanical 0
  - d. Rapid tranquilisation 358\*
  - \* 305 incidents involved both physical restraint and rapid tranquilisation so have been recorded under both categories
- 2. How many incidents of Restrictive Interventions were recorded per 1000 bed hours in mental health units in your Trust in the year 2016/17?" **The Trust does not hold this information.**

- 8. Does your Trust have a policy in place for a Restrictive Intervention Reduction Programme? Please provide a copy of or a link to the most recent policy?

  The Trust has operational policies for the training model(s) delivered in support of service users and staff. Policies place emphasis in the reduction in the use of all restrictive practices. In addition a mulita-disciplinary Positive and Safe group is actively focusing in this area of practice. The group is a sub-committee of the Trust Governance committee.
- 9. How often has restrictive intervention training at your Trust been reviewed? Please provide a copy of or a link to the most recent documents relating to any review of restrictive intervention training.
  - Restrictive Intervention training is discussed and reviewed on an ongoing basis in a number of forums. e.g. Positive and Safe sub-committee.
- 10. Is training provided in house or by an external provider? If the latter, which training provider does your Trust currently use to teach restrictive interventions?
  All training components relating to the reduction and safe manage behaviours that challenge is delivered by an in-house training team (Behaviour Support & Training Team). The Trust currently delivers two discrete models; Positive Behaviour Management (PBM) and Preventing and Managing Violence and Aggression (PMVA). Whilst the training teams are trained and accredited by external bodies, we act independently of those bodies in the delivery of the in-house training programmes.
- 11. What were the factors which led to the decision to provide training either in house or by an external provider?
  - There are a number of factors that have influenced the decision to deliver training inhouse. Each training model is targeted to appropriately meet unique service user group requirements. Using the Train the Trainer approach has enabled the Trust to provide a flexible training programme delivered by a dedicated team throughout the year. Using the programmes as a "menu" we are able to develop training packages to meet the needs of staff groups which is driven by the need of service users they support. Therefore, the risk of over or under training staff is reduced, resulting in better training and service delivery outcomes. In addition, delivering the training by means of an inhouse team provides a cost effective solution to meeting this important training need.
- 12. When does your current training provider contract expire? Do you have measures in place to re-visit your training provider through open tendering in order to ensure your staff are receiving the highest quality training?
  The contracts that exist with both training providers are relating to Training trainers
  - only. These are "rolling" in nature. All training provided annually at which point skills are assessed, newly developed skills training provided and there is an opportunity for the training lead to highlight any organisational needs. However, the Trust maintain a positive and open relationship with both organisation which is designed to enable dialogue throughout the year to ensure we remain satisfied that staff are receiving the highest quality training, and that service needs are being appropriately met.
- 13. What proportion of the restrictive intervention training programme at your Trust is dedicated to de-escalation? Where possible, please specify what percentage of your restrictive intervention training programme at your Trust is dedicated to teaching and assessing staff competencies in the following areas:
  - In line with national practice guidance, all Staff are provided with dedicated proactive preventative theory component (Conflict Resolution) on a three yearly cycle which includes individual or organisational factors that may contribute to the presentation of

behaviour that may challenge services, effective interpersonal skills and communication; active / effective listening skills; effective verbal and de-escalation skills. Practical skills training and assessment is delivered annually. However, during all physical skills training sessions, proactive reduction / preventative strategies are revisited along with the legal framework to ensure that their importance is continually underpinned to ensure that the least restrictive approaches are always considered.

a. Delivering person-centred trauma sensitive care and support Emphasis is placed on this area of practice both in the conflict resolution and importantly underpinned during physical skills training.

c. Crisis/Reactive Physical Interventions

- b. Proactive and preventative skills (e.g. effective interpersonal skills; effective listening skills; effective verbal and de-escalation skills)

  Predominantly during the conflict resolution component, however, during the Physical skills training around 30 % of the time is used to continually reiterate the need for person centred care strategies being implemented to reduce the likelihood of restrictive practice being used.
- The approach to training is not a "one size fits all". Depending on workplace environment / service user group supported, the training is based on a needs analysis. Staff are only provided with physical skills that are required within their workplace e.g. community staff would be provided with training in keep safe, self-protection techniques (use of environment, personal space Breakaway blocks and disengagement), whereas an inpatient staff team supporting what may potentially be more complex behavioural presentation will also be given training in a range of more restrictive physical interventions that are suited to the service need. Attention is

always paid to the health and wellbeing of service users. To this end great emphasis is also placed on ensuring that individual service user health needs are understood and

- d. Approaches for post crisis support and learning
  Strategies for recognising and supporting the need for this area of practice are
  provided predominantly during the theoretical component, however, underpinned
  during all physical skills training. Knowledge is shared which focuses on an
  individual personally seeking support, guidance around providing support both for
  an individual and a whole team. Importantly, equal emphasis is placed on the need of
  the service user following any incident, both physically and psychologically. In all
  cases the aim is to ensure the wellbeing of all individuals and to attempt to reduce the
  likelihood of further incidents through understanding causation.
  This is an area of great importance, and therefore remains an ongoing agenda point
  in the 2gether Trust Positive and Safe Sub Committee.




## Reducing Restrictive Interventions Action Plan 2017/18- Older People Inpatient - Organic Secondary Drivers








#### Reducing Restrictive Interventions Action Plan 2017/18- Older People Inpatient - Functional




