There isn't a specific team, individual teams do as and when required we do not offer this service freely like Acute Services
- 2. Do you provide a 7 day week service? Yes, the service is provided as required.
- 3. Approximately how many bookings are made each year (if possible please split this into inpatient and outpatient visits)? In the last financial year (2017-18) we were aware of 90 Non-Secure bookings and 139 Secure bookings. The Trust does not hold data that specifies the reasons.
- 4. Who else is involved in the process Please list each stakeholder for example Nurse, Bed Manager, Sisters/Matrons, Finance, CCG Finance, CCG Transport Provider, Own Transport Department, Other? Inpatient Teams, Nurses, Bed Management, Administrators, Community Teams, Finance, CCG Finance, Transport Provider, Taxi

- 6. What systems and applications do you use to capture and track the transport bookings? We use a combination of spreadsheets and a booking portal provided by 365 Response (secure transport bookings only).
