Report	Since 2016, every NHS Trust has had to have a guardian of safe working.		
	The guardian of safe working checks that doctors have safe working hours. They check that doctors have training and support. They do this to help keep patients and doctors safe.		
Results	 Since 2nd August 2017 there have been 27 issues raised: 22 issues were about number of working hours 4 issues were about service support 1 issue was about chances to learn. ² gether has not been fined for these issues.
