Have you heard of 'MY HEALTH PASSPORT'?



No what is MY HEALTH PASSPORT?

I can tell you!



<u>MY HEALTH PASSPORT</u> is a <u>NEW EASY READ</u> 'grab sheet' that could accompany a person who requires reasonable adjustments to their health care, when they have a health appointment or go into hospital whether the admission is an emergency or planned.

That is a REALLY GOOD idea! Where can I get one?



I know because I have one! I contacted the Health Facilitation Team on FREEPHONE 0800 019 3346 and asked if Simon or Karin could send me a pre printed one in the post. And they said YES! It looks like this.



My Health Passport was produced by the GHC Learning Disability Health Facilitation Team following consultation with Learning Disability partners in Gloucestershire Hospital NHS Foundation Trust, the All Disability Provider Forum and a countywide survey.
